EL CAMINO COUNTRY CLUB RULES OF PLAY

PACE OF PLAY: Four and a half hours maximum for 18 holes is required.

GOLF CARS: Remain at least 30 yards from the greens and on the paths at all times on par-3 holes.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Defined as areas of deficient turf marked with solid white painted lines or stakes and rope that completely enclose an area; or piles of debris, natural or unnatural, collected or placed for removal or disbursement; or deep tire tracks, ruts or damage made by maintenance vehicles or golf cars, not including shallow indentations; or areas of new sod marked with small flags; or areas of obvious course construction that are not marked.

FLOWER BEDS: Flower beds on holes 7, 11, 14, 15, 16, 17, and 18 shall be treated as protected areas. Players are prohibited from playing in these areas and must obtain relief without penalty at the nearest point outside the flower bed within one club-length, not nearer the hole.

OBSTRUCTIONS: Exposed pipes used for irrigation, french drains, and concrete culverts, that are not within the confines of a hazard, are considered immovable obstructions and players shall receive relief without penalty.

STAKED TREES: In order to avoid damaging newly planted trees, free relief at the nearest point within one club-length, not nearer the hole, shall be provided if a staked tree interferes with a player's stance or swing.

AERATION HOLES: A ball that comes to rest in or on an aeration hole may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where it lay, not nearer the hole.

SPRINKLERS NEAR THE GREEN: If a player's ball lies off the putting green, but not in a hazard and an immovable obstruction, such as a sprinkler, on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief. When taking relief the ball must be dropped at the nearest point to where the ball originally lay that avoids intervention, not nearer the hole, not on the green, and not in a hazard.

EMBEDDED BALL: Played through the green.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Defined by white stakes on all 18 holes and any part of holes 5 or 9 when playing hole 4.

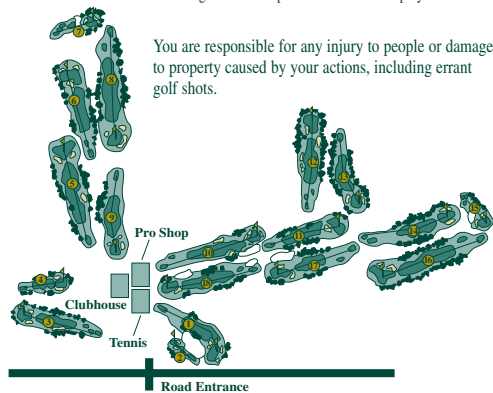
WATER HAZARDS: Defined by solid yellow painted lines or yellow stakes.

LATERAL WATER HAZARDS: Defined by solid red painted lines or red stakes.

SPECIAL DROP AREAS: A drop circle has been provided as an additional option for any ball hit into the water hazard on hole 7 or the lateral water hazard on hole 17.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES: Devices that measure distance only, GPS, laser or similar are permitted. Devices that gauge or measure other conditions, e.g., wind or slope, are not permitted.

POWER LINES: Ball striking an elevated power line must be replayed.
